**Wrestlers Must Wear Singlet at Weigh-ins**  
(Two Piece Uniforms are Acceptable)

This is a qualifier for the WWF Kids Folkstyle State Championships to be held March 22nd through 24<sup>th</sup> at the Alliant Energy Center in Madison. In the boys and girls divisions, the TOP THREE place winners in each age and weight class qualify for the State Championships. All qualifiers must make the same weight class at the State Championships that they qualified for at the Qualifier; There is no weight allowance at the state tournament.

**Wrestlers must be born in the year listed for each age division.** Wrestlers born in 2009 cannot be in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Wrestlers cannot compete in a high school tournament. Athletes must wrestle in gender appropriate division unless a comparable competition is not offered. Your **current USA Card** must be shown at weigh-ins and is required to preregister on Trackwrestling. **Warning:** WIAA fingernail length rule will be enforced. WIAA mouth guard will be enforced for wrestlers with braces. Skin Checks will be done. Girls must wear a female-cut singlet or wear an approved undergarment underneath their singlet.

**Coaches:** Coaches are required to hold a current USA Wrestling Leader membership card, which can be purchased online through [USA Wrestling's membership system](#). Wrestling leaders complete mandatory safesport training and a background check through USA Wrestling. Please allow up to two weeks for the background check to go through. This is the same membership required to coach at the WWF State Folkstyle Tournament, and Dominate in the Dells, which are USA Wrestling sanctioned events hosted by the WWF in March 2024. With this membership in USA Wrestling, one will be able to access the National Coaches Education Program certification and be able to coach at chartered club practices as well. By purchasing the membership in advance of the qualifiers, anyone needing to complete the Copper (or higher) certification will have the entire week of the WWF State Folkstyle Tournament.
